Dear Parish Family & Friends,

Welcome to all who join us this weekend to celebrate the 116th Feast of the Assumption at Holy Rosary. We are honored by your presence in this church, which holds such special memories for so many people. We continue to give thanks to God for His blessings to us as we honor the glorious assumption of our Blessed Mother into heaven.

What is it that makes this Feast and this parish so special to so many? For some it is the tradition – walking in procession upon those same streets that their great-grandparents walked and reflecting upon happy memories from their childhood. For others it is the food and festivities – enjoying the atmosphere of several city blocks closed off with thousands of people gathered together. For many, it is the opportunity to gather with family and friends who travel long distances to celebrate the Feast each year. All of these play a small part in some way. However, the reality of what makes it special transcends all of this. Our faith makes the Feast special and the fact that we share it in a unique way during these days.

This is what our Holy Father Pope Francis calls us to do – share our faith. Reflecting on the assumption statue of Mary, she holds out her arms to us, inviting us into an ever-deepening relationship with her Son. She invites us to first deepen our faith and then to share that same faith with others just as she did. Mary shared her faith when she went to visit Elizabeth. Mary shared her faith at the wedding at Cana. And Mary shared her faith through her presence at the foot of the Cross. In sum, Mary shared her faith in charitable service, in proclamation, and in unwavering presence. That is our challenge as well. Let us accept it with the courage that comes from the Holy Spirit.

We conclude the Feast with the candlelight procession on Sunday evening, followed by a prayer service. This is a wonderful opportunity for us to proclaim our faith, to be unwavering in bringing Christ's presence to others, and hopefully leads us to continuing acts of charitable service throughout our lives. As we give praise and glory to Almighty God during the Feast for the singular grace given to our Blessed Mother and Patroness through her Glorious Assumption, let us be mindful of what makes this special – our Faith – that reminds us that one day we, too, will share heaven with Mary.
