Dear Parish Family,

Next weekend will be our parish annual cooperative mission appeal. This appeal is coordinated by the office for the Society of the Propagation of the Faith and Diocesan Mission Office. Once a year, each parish participates by having a missionary priest preach at all Masses to solicit funds for their particular missionary activity within the universal Church, as well as to increase awareness of the various missionary efforts. This year, Holy Rosary will host Fr. Librado Baluarte from the diocese of Sorsogon, Philippines, as our missionary preacher.

Father will speak to us about the missionary work in that part of the world and their need for assistance to continue the spread of the Gospel. Specifically, the critical needs in Sorsogon are:

For the education of our 130 seminarians (80 in High School, 40 in College, 10 in Theology). Most parents of these young boys are poor and cannot afford to give them a priestly education, which has become more costly through the years. The Province of Sorsogon is one of the poorest in the region of Bicol, which is often hit by natural calamities, such as typhoons (hurricanes) and volcanic eruptions.

For our pastoral programs which focus on the formation of our lay men and women, who are leaders in the Village Chapel Pastoral Councils. These lay leaders need continuing training so that they can effectively help the Parish Priests in the implementation of the Diocesan Ecclesial and Evangelization Program (DEEP), which is intended for the economic, political, cultural and religious development of the people.

Our generous participation in this mission appeal allows us to share in the worldwide call to spread the gospel message by assisting those whose resources limit their ability to do so. Let us pray for the success of the missionary efforts throughout our world so that the Truth of the Gospel may be preached to all nations.
