SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER MAY 10, 2015

Dear Parish Family,

Today we celebrate the Sixth Sunday of Easter on the liturgical calendar and Mother's Day on the secular calendar. As Providence guides all things, the scriptures for today perfectly reflect the meaning of the day. Jesus tells us to remain in His love and commands us to love one another. Is there any better model for this than the love of a mother for her children? It is a special bond that begins when a mother first learns of her pregnancy, caring for the child in her womb by how she cares for herself, through diet and proper prenatal care. That unconditional love never ceases throughout the mother's life. It is that same type of love Christ has for each of us, His beloved sons and daughters. And it is only in remaining in Christ's love that our earthly mothers are able to shower us with the tender love and care that they do.

This love manifests itself in so many ways and oftentimes it is the simplest ways that impact us the most. Think of a mother who holds her young child when sick or when they fall and get hurt; who privately cries at their first day of school realizing that they need to begin to let go; who stays awake and worries when their child is away at night and cannot rest until they are home safely. Just as we are able to run to our earthly mothers for our physical care and needs, we are able to run to Mary to spiritually care for us, letting us know everything is going to be fine amidst our struggles and anxieties. Mary is always willing to hold us in her arms and comfort us. If you have never done so, try praying with that in mind and see how

our Blessed Mother responds to your request.

On this Mother's Day, let us remain in Christ's love for us. Allow that love to help us love one another as Jesus commands us, and always remember the best models for this love are our mothers and Mary.
