My Dear Parish Family,

On this final day of the Easter Season, it is most appropriate that we wish each other a sincere, "Happy Birthday!" *Happy Birthday*, you may ask? Before you call Fr. Joe and recommend that he have the mental faculties of this deacon checked out, let me explain. Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, the day on which the promised Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary and empowered them to proclaim "the mighty works of God." In this colossal event of our salvation history, the Church – the body of believers charged with the duty of making disciples of all the nations – was born. We, as today's members of the Body of Christ, can trace our origins to this very day. Just as we celebrate the anniversary of our natural birth each year as that date rolls around so do we celebrate our birth as a Church today.

We are all familiar with the tradition of receiving gifts on one's birthday. On this Pentecost day we call to mind that Father and the Son sent the most perfect gift of their Holy Spirit to us. The Holy Spirit, eternal, powerful and ever at work in the Church is truly the *gift that keeps on giving*. The Holy Spirit is a gift we receive both collectively as Church working through Pope, bishops and the teachings, and individually through God's word and the sacraments. As usual, the Father and Jesus cannot be outdone in generosity!

And what is a birthday celebration without singing? If you are reading this before Mass that is good because you still have a chance to join in the chorus. No, the words we sing are not what you expect but rather God's word in the responsorial psalm:

***"Lord, send out your Spirit, and  
renew the face of the earth."***

This prayerful plea acknowledges the incredible gift of the Holy Spirit and asks God to put us to work in bringing His Kingdom forth.

Every time you participate in the celebration of the Mass, YOU have an opportunity to proclaim God's word to yourselves by joining in the singing of the responsorial psalm. If you are reading this after Mass, that is okay too. Just keep this in mind for the next time. If you have read this during Mass, I am sorry that you are missing the celebration.
